SUGGESTED CANOE TRIPS

AS YOU MAY KNOW! Paddle time on the river can vary depending of the flow of the river.

With the river flow at 15,000 CFS float time without paddling is about 4 miles per hour.

When the river flow is at 10,000 CFS float time without paddling is about 3 miles per hour.

To find out what the river flow is you can go to Canoeing at our web site and click on Keswick Dam river flow information at the bottom of page.

BEGINNER GROUP...

REDDING TO RED BLUFF CAMPGROUNDS... This is a 3 day trip, with paddle time on the water approximately 4 to 5 hours a day. You will float between 14 to 18 miles a days, and travel a total of 52 miles starting from the posse grounds in Redding and ending up at the Red Bluff Camp Grounds.

To extend your trip you could portage the canoes around the diversion dam at Red Bluff and canoe another 16 miles to Driftwood. This would save money by avoiding the shuddle pick-up of the canoes at the Red Bluff diversion dam.

Recommended campsites: Prior notice is required and the fee will vary.

1. Posse grounds to Anderson River Park about 15 miles... contact the Anderson Park at 530-378-6656 no charge call for details.

2. Posse grounds to Reading Island about 23 miles... contact Bill Coats at the Bureau of Land Management 530-224-2157 no charge.

3. Posse grounds to Balls Ferry Fishing Resort about 25 miles... contact Mike or Chris at 530-365-8708.

ADVANCED GROUP...

REDDING TO RED BLUFF CAMPGROUNDS... This is a 2 day trip, with paddle time on the water approximately 7 to 8 hours a day. You will float and paddle between 22 to 25 miles a day, traveling a total of 52 miles. You will start at the Posse grounds in Redding and end at the Red Bluff Campgrounds.

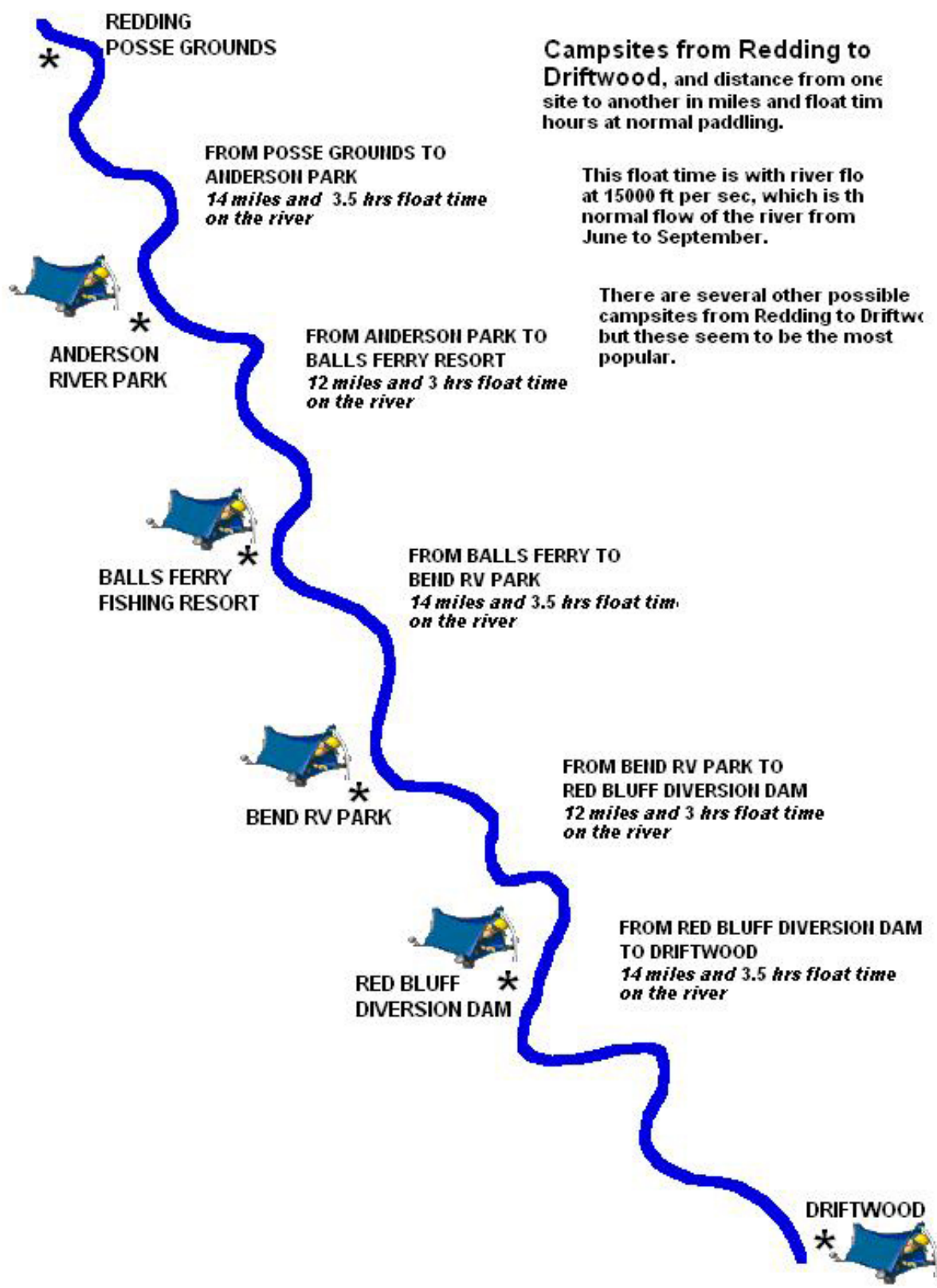
Recommended campsites: Prior notice is required and the fee will vary.

To extend your trip you could portage the canoes around the diversion dam at Red Bluff and canoe another 16 miles to Driftwood. This would save money by avoiding the shuttle pick-up of the canoes at the Red Bluff diversion dam.

The above information is for the first timers! There could be other campsites along the river, but these are the known safe and reliable campsites.

This 52-mile floating adventure will range from the scenic beauty of Iron Canyon, to challenging the class I whitewaters of China Rapids. There may be exciting multi-canoe recoveries, and an occasional involuntary dip or two in the 52 degree water that will quickly bring on a chill. You will enjoy feeding the ducks and geese swimming on the river's surface, and viewing the trout and salmon swarming in the emerald green water below. And, then there will be the thrill of sighting a family of deer grazing along the river bank. See Egrets, Herons, Ospreys, and even a Bald Eagle or two stalking the river waters for a fish dinner. And best of all... there will be the unbelievable crimson sunsets and sunrises, and the star-cluttered night skies that will leave you breathless. Truly, this is a one of a kind adventure, and memories of this water trek will last a lifetime.



Campsites from Redding to Driftwood, and distance from one site to another in miles and float time hours at normal paddling.

This float time is with river flow at 15000 ft per sec, which is the normal flow of the river from June to September.

There are several other possible campsites from Redding to Driftwood but these seem to be the most popular.

WARNING: YOU ARE ADVISED THAT LIFE JACKETS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIME WHEN IN CANOES OR BOATS.

YOU AGREE: TO CARRY THE CANOE TO AND FROM THE WATER, AND TO AND FROM THE CANOE TRAILER OR TRUCK.

1. It is understood that prior to leaving on a canoe/boat trip, the party renting a canoe(s) and equipment associated therewith shall fully inspect all equipment prior to its use. Owner shall be advised of any defects in the equipment. The use of said equipment will constitute an acceptance on a rental basis "AS IS".

2. I understand that there are risks of physical injury, death, and damage to property from canoeing on rivers and other bodies of water, and from camping. I fully realize that Driftwood RV Park & Fishing Resort, or its agents, have no control over the manner, use, or the condition of any river, lake, stream, or other body of water. In consideration for Driftwood RV Park & Fishing Resort accepting my rental fee and for their renting to me a canoe(s) for my use, I am therefore willing to assume the risk and responsibility for any such injury, death or damage to personal property which I (or any minor on whose behalf I am signing this Release), my heirs, children, dependents, and all other persons may sustain arising out of the renting and / or use of a canoe(s) from Driftwood RV Park & Fishing Resort, or the taking of any trip with Driftwood RV Park & Fishing Resort, or the taking of any trip which uses any said canoe(s) from Driftwood RV Park & Fishing Resort, including injury, death or damage resulting from any action, whether negligent or not, by Driftwood RV Park, its employees, agents, other participants on the trip or myself.

3. I understand that all of equipment provided by Driftwood RV Park & Fishing Resort is at the undersigned's own risk, and I agree to pay for any damage done to said equipment or property.

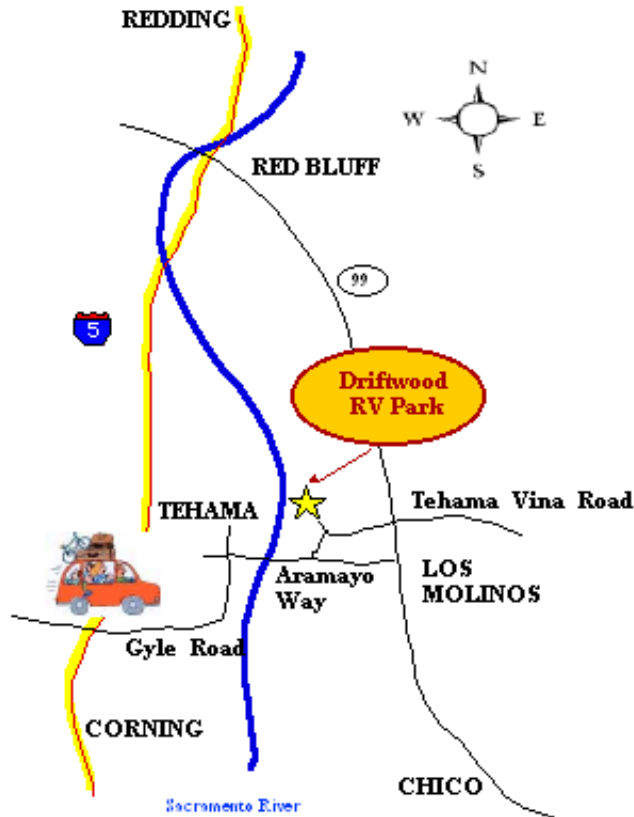

DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

Take Gyle Road Exit I-5 5 miles north of Corning and 10 miles south of Red Bluff, and only 7 miles off the I-5 freeway in the historic community of Los Molinos.

From I-5 take the Gyle Road exit and drive east to the town of Tehama., there will be a stop sign at the intersection of 5th and "C" Street, turn right on "C" Street and go across the Sacramento River. Turn left at the Driftwood RV Park sign and follow signs to the office.

Driftwood is Located at 24630 Tehama Vina Road in Los Molinos. Tehama Vina Road crosses Highway 99 East approximately 10 miles south on 99 from Red Bluff and 20 miles north on 99 from Chico.

Landmarks to look for on Highway 99: Fast Track Gas Station, and Bar 99 are both on the west corner of Highway 99 and Tehama Vina Road.
